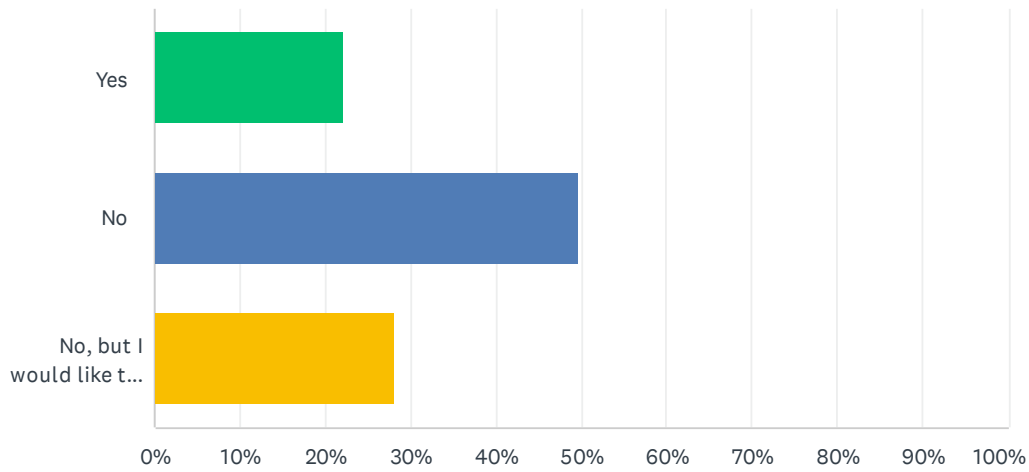


## Q1 Do you attend local chapter meetings?

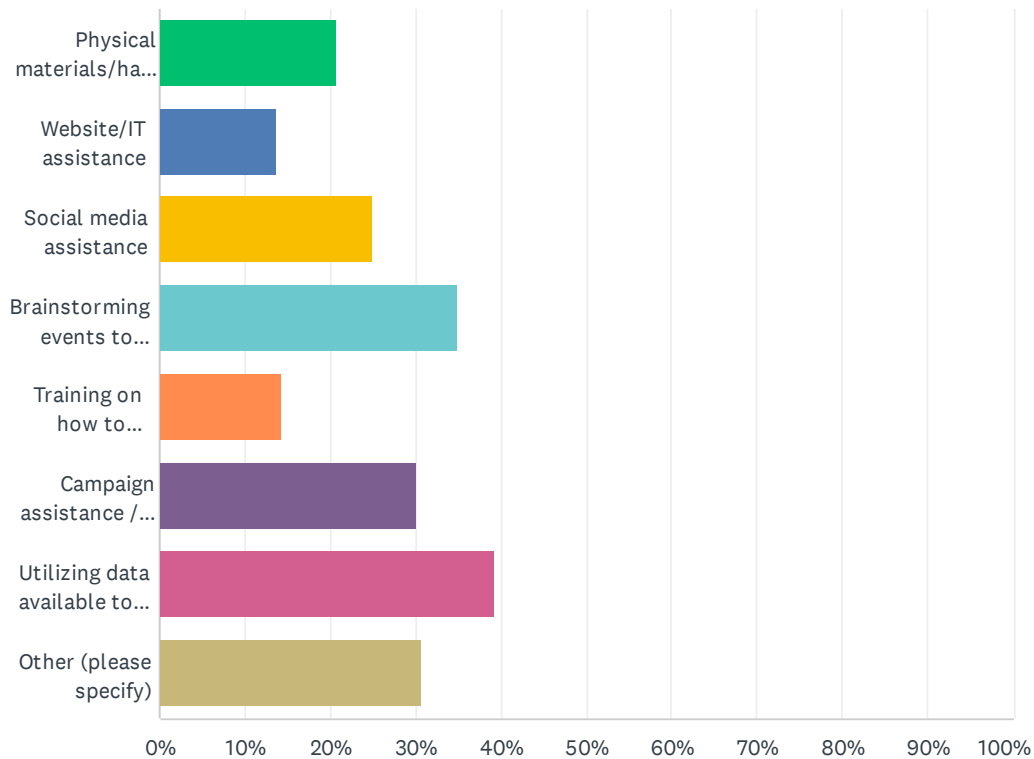

## Q2 What support does your local chapter need?

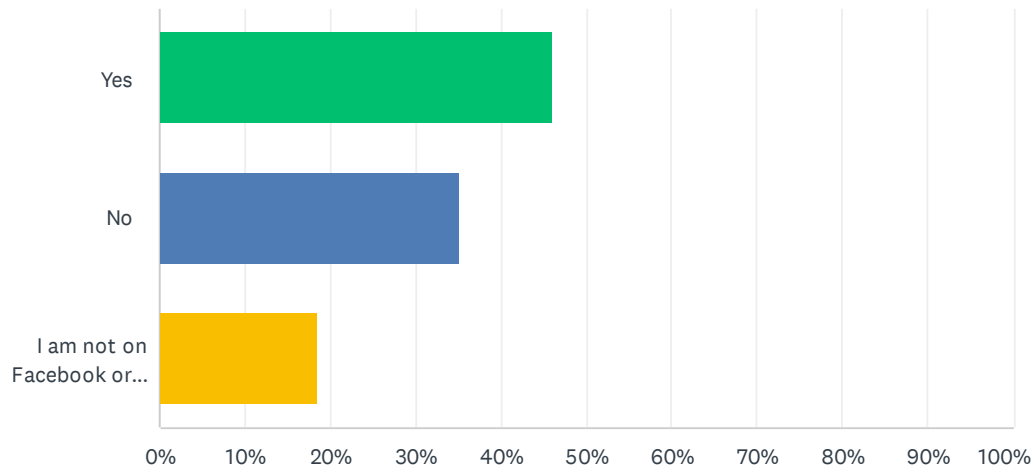

### Q3 Do you frequently see LP Illinois content on Facebook or Twitter?

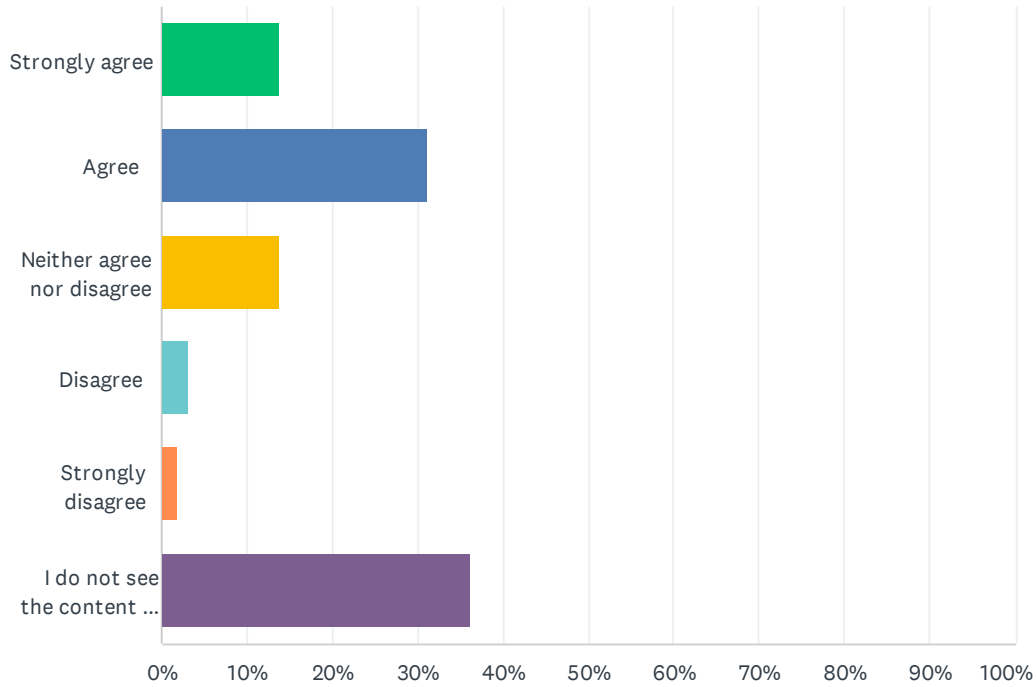

## Q4 I approve of the content on the LP Illinois official Facebook or Twitter accounts.

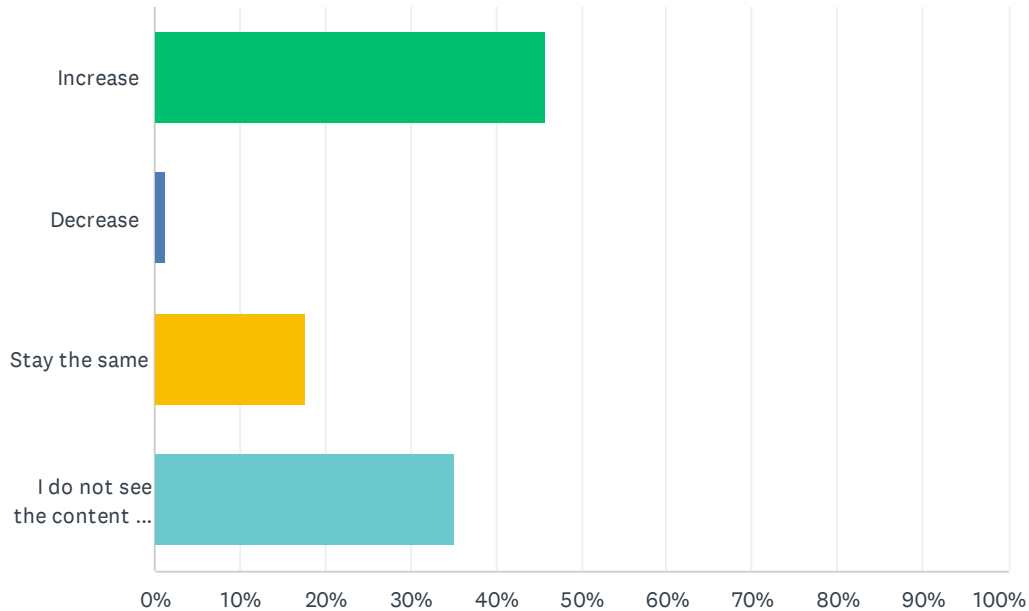

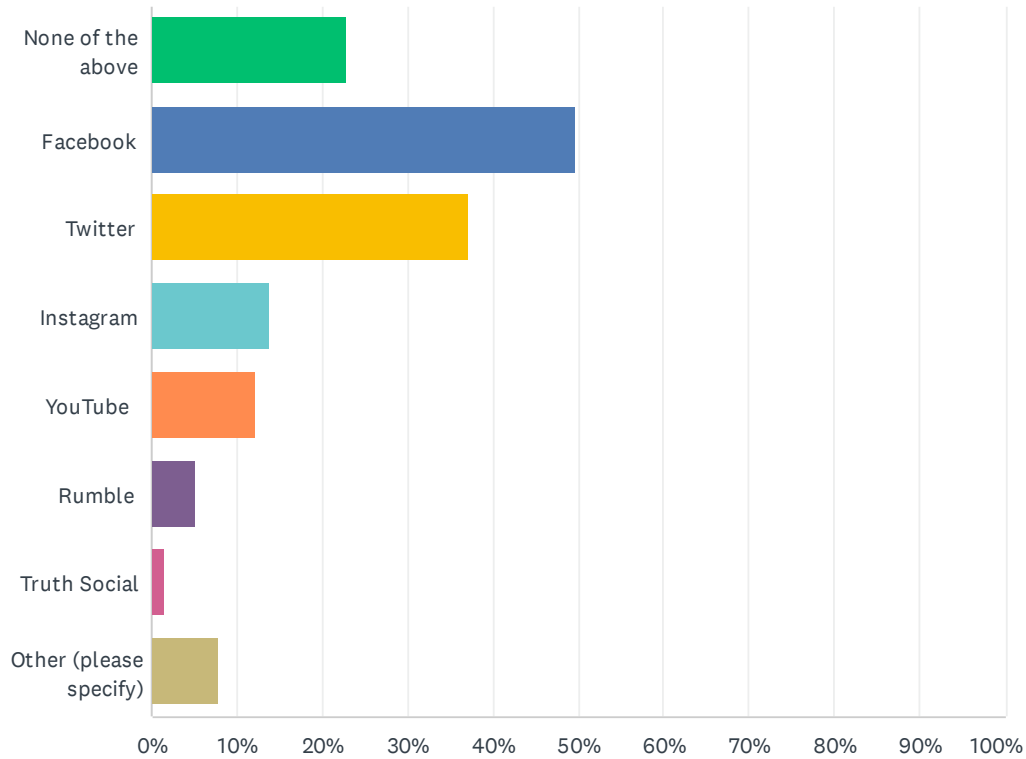

## Q6 Please identify the social media sites where you frequently see NATIONAL LP content:

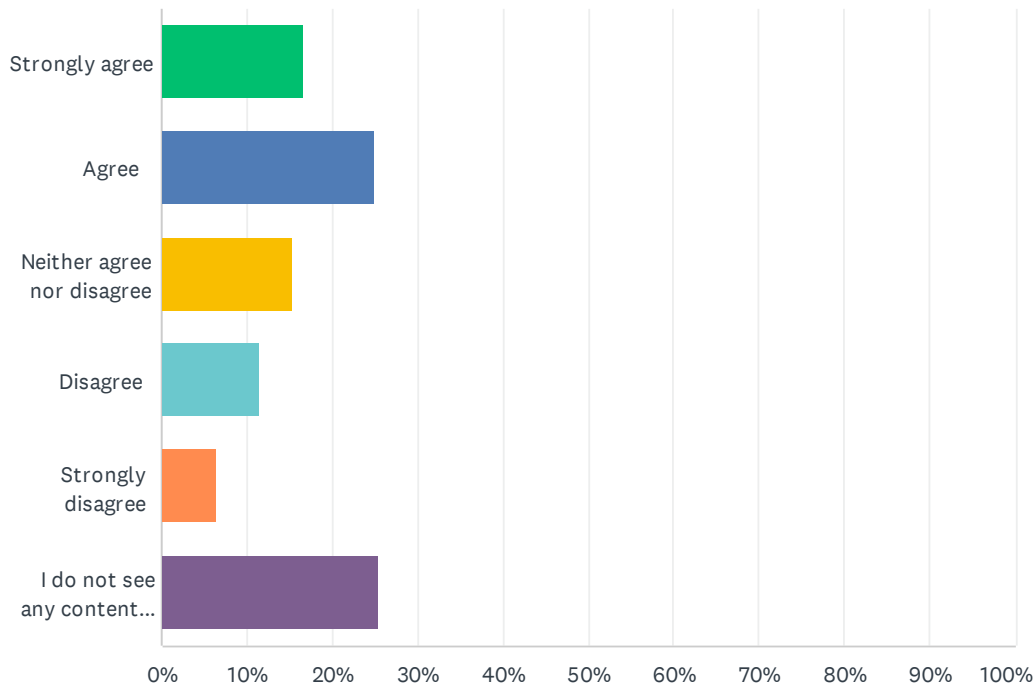

## Q7 I approve of the content on the NATIONAL LP's social media accounts.

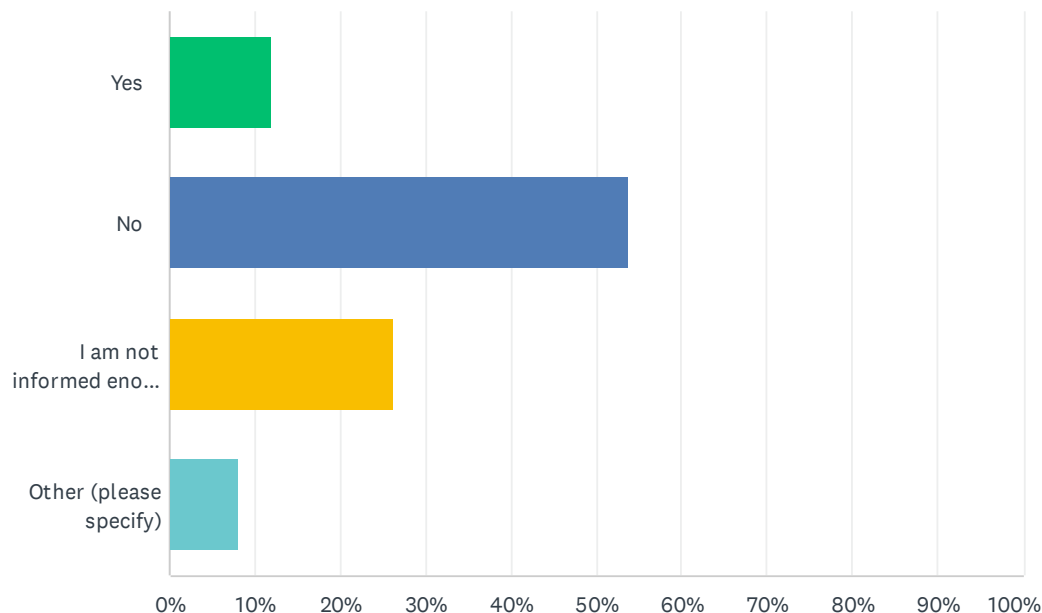

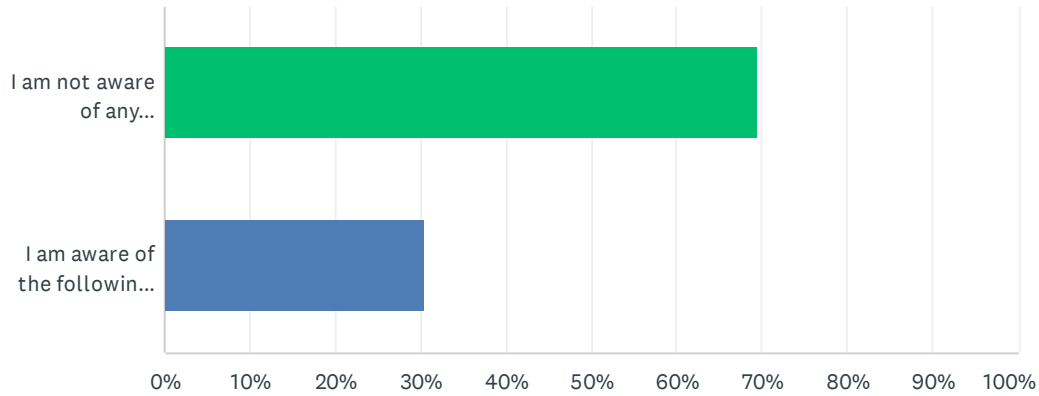

## Q9 Which presidential candidates are you aware of who are seeking the Libertarian Party's 2024 nomination?

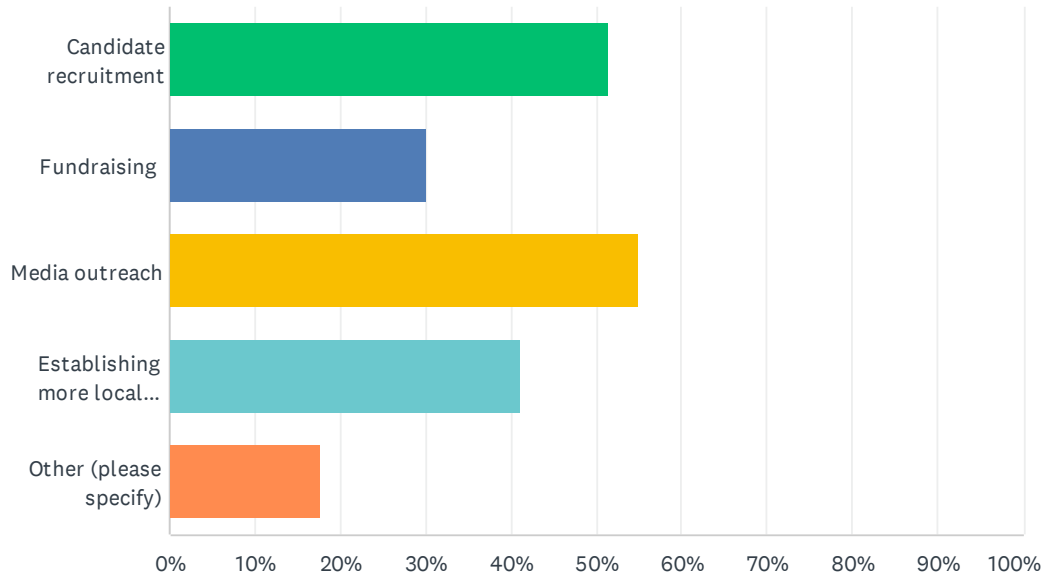
