Officer Reports

Chair Report –

The chair reported that he has been working on the application for the portal and has added the state that each delegate lives in, if it's not the state they are a delegate for. He has also added a place for the committee to add internal notes.

He also stated that he's been contacted by 3 or 4 people asking how they can contest either state or individual delegates and he suggested they send an email to the committee.

Vice Chair Report –

The Vice Chair reported that there are still four states that have only one delegate in the system; Delaware, Hawaii, Rhode Island and Wyoming. He hasn't heard back from Delaware, Hawaii, or Rhode Island, however Wyoming is saying they are having trouble logging into the system and they are working on that.

Also working on which states need national. Currently he's identified seven states that require national membership; Louisiana, Oklahoma, Indiana, Nevada, Oregon, New Mexico, and California. Mimi Robson stated that Louisiana doesn't require national membership due to a motion to suspend the rules at their state convention to not require national membership for this convention.

At the end of the Vice Chair report, the Chair further reported that he has spoken to the Chair of the National Committee and he will be providing the committee with a list of national members for the purpose of checking that for states that require national membership.
