

Good morning

I have the distinct honor of presenting to you, the Report of the Credentials Committee at the 2026 Libertarian National Convention.

I would respectfully ask that this report be permitted to be delivered in its entirety prior to any motions.

We have 539 primary delegates qualified and checked in to the convention and are credentialed.

We have 15 alternates qualified and checked in to the convention and are credentialed.

The credentials committee has several items to bring to the convention body for resolution. The credentials committee was unable to qualify or check in the following delegates.

For the Commonwealth of Kentucky – Matt Harris of Michigan was added on May 20th and the committee was unable to verify his National Party membership.

For the state of New Mexico – The following alternates were not qualified due to a state party requirement that delegates be state residents:

For the state of Oregon – Mark Edgington of New Hampshire has been confirmed to be a registered Republican in the state of New Hampshire, and Oregon's state party bylaws prevent members of another party from being a delegate. The Credentials Committee specifically recommends against seating Mr. Edgington.

With 539 primary delegates, the voting thresholds are as follows:

- Majority: 270
- 2/3rds: 360

- 3/4ths: 405
- 7/8ths: 472

Quorum is 40% of the credentialed primary delegates, or a total of 216 delegates.

In closing, I thank the members of the Credentials Committee who worked efficiently and fairly to credential all of you in a timely manner, and to the delegates for making this process as smooth as possible.

On behalf of the Credentials Committee, I move the acceptance of this opening report of the credentials committee at the 2026 Libertarian National Convention.
